

Valery P. Bobotov - doctor of technical sciences, professor, artist. Born in 1946 in Petzamo, brought up by his father's parents in Siberia, grew up among the artists (his uncle with friends) who inoculate in him a taste for fine arts.

After finishing secondary school graduated from the Maritime College in Vladivostok (at present FESMA), then worked on ships of the Far Eastern Shipping Co., studied at art colleges, worked as an assistant professor, then as a professor teaching descriptive geometry, drawing, computer graphics. The subject of the thesis is «Descriptive Geometry of the Multidimensional Space and Its Application in Engineering and Arts». In engineering this is ship surface design, in art this is creation of aesthetic forms of larger size with their subsequent conform, topological and other transformations.

CREATIVE WORK

From 1969 - studying at art workshops of Vladivostok and the Art Department of the Correspondence People's University (Moscow).

1974-1980 - member of the Young Artists Union of Leningrad and the USSR.

From 1972 - presents his works (drawings, etchings, lithography, monotypes, computer graphics) at various exhibitions.

From 1994 - engaged in computer graphics. This is composition and design of the book of his friend F. Konyuhov, the book «Indigirka Death» about the tragedy happened to the soviet sailors in 1939 in Japan near Hokkaido and the collections of poems of L. Annimov, director the Theatre
